Provisional

January 6th – Group AGM starting at 9.30am in the conservatory at WGC and short walk to follow

February 10th – Winter Visit to Potteric Carr meet at 10.30am insects emerging from hibernation, trees and flowers in bud

March 11th – Walk along the TPT by the railway line at Elsecar to look at hedgerows, meet in the car park at 10am.

April 14th – Moth Trapping and Pond Dipping in Historic Gardens at WGC, meet at the entrance to the gardens at 10am

May 5th – Spring visit to Staveley Wild Life Trust Reserve a chance to see flowers and trees as they start growing and hear bird song, meet in the car park at 11am

June 10th – Evening Visit to Old Moor wild flowers and orchids meet in the car park at 5.30pm;
Remember to be off the reserve by 8pm

June 27th - 30th – Summer at the Seaside a short break to Brightlingsea, staying 3 nights B&B including a day visit to Mersea Island, wildlife along the sea wall and a special guided walk from Roger Tabor over the salt marshes, more details to follow – **booking is essential**

July 22nd – Biodiversity in Long Grass Area at Wentworth Garden Centre, studying and recording the species found in the habitats we have created at the back of the farm; meet outside the entrance to the farm at 10am

August 11th – Visit to Adwick for birds, wild flowers & grasses, meet in the car park at 10am

September 8th – Visit to Sprotbrough Flash Woodlands for late summer flowers and birds, car share is essential as there is limited parking, meet in the car park on Nursery Lane at 10am

October 13th – Bird Migration at North Cave autumn bird identification, car share and meet in the car park at 11am

November 11th – Autumn Visit to Wombwell Woods fungi, plant galls and birds, park in the station car park and meet at 10am

December 9th – Winter at Gypsy Marsh and Broomhill Flash Park in the car park opposite Gypsy Marsh at 10am
